#### CHURCH, CLUB, ORGANIZATION HISTORIES



# Instructions for submitting family, church or organization histories:

**Credits:** Each article submitted must be signed by the writer. Words must be counted and noted at the end of the article. Under the signature, type or print clearly your name, address and telephone number.

**Photos:** We invite you to send one or more photographs with each family history. One photo is included at no charge ... additional photos are \$15.00 each to print. Type photo captions at the end of the family story. If more than one photo number caption and photos, Number 1 and 2 etc. Do not send us and original photo, please send us a copy. Snapshots and studio photos are great, b/w or color. We will make a sincere effort to return all copies, however we assume no responsibility for their loss or damage.

**Word Limit:** There is a 500 word limit on the family stories, and a 1,000 limit on all other stories (clubs, organizations, business, churches). Each word over 500 family, or other stories over 1,000 will be charged 10 cents per word.

Writing Format: Stories must be typed in Microsoft word with family photo and "sent to forklandhistorybook@gmail.com. For those who do not have access to a computer or Microsoft word there will be a Forkland Community Center member available at the Community Center every Tuesday from 10:00AM- 2:00PM and Saturday 12:00 Noon-4:00PM to assist in the submission process. Your story must be written as it will appear in the history book with a family photo. Deadline for receiving family information and photos is December 1, 2024.
